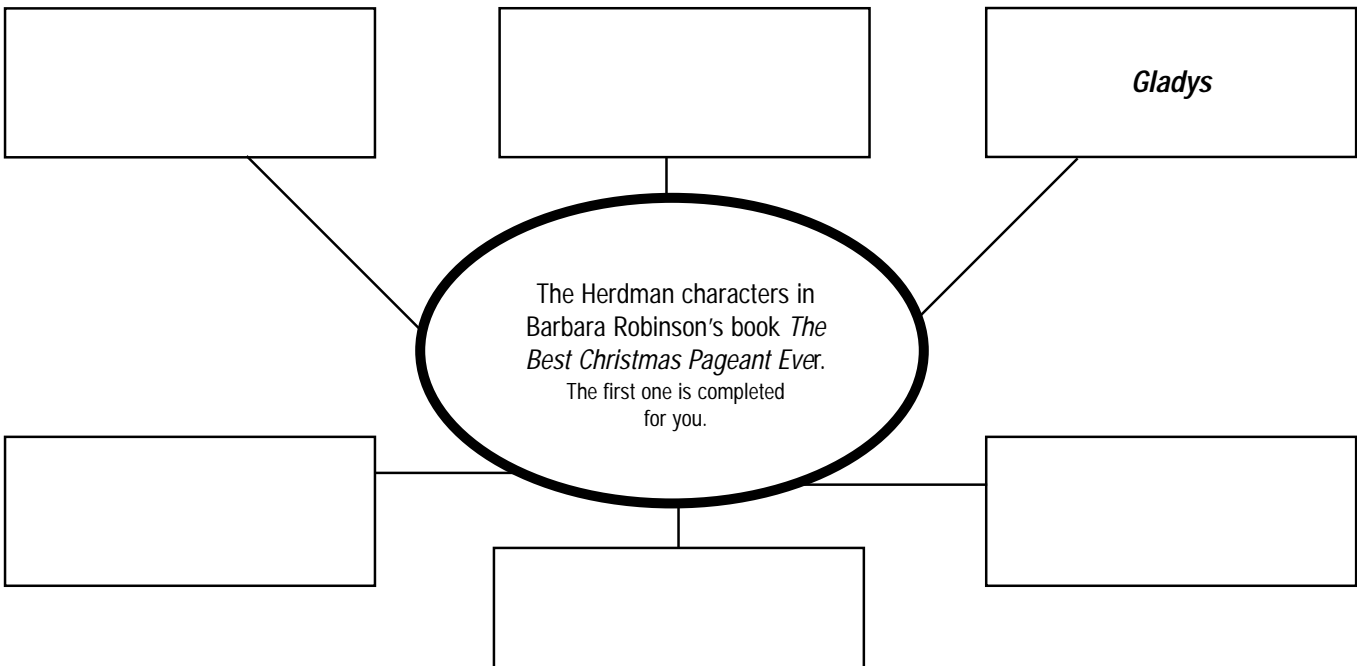

What is the the volume number and issue number of your newspaper?

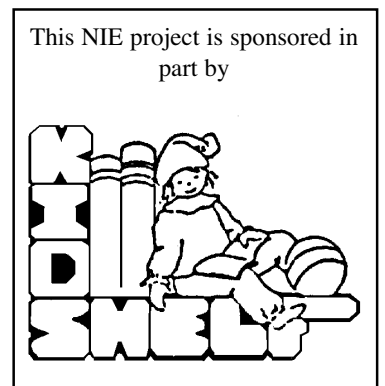
