

2010-2011 MVHS Student Dress Code Description

Students may wear the following:

1. Shoes- Must have a closed toe and should have a maximum heel height of 3” or less. (Tennis shoes are permitted, flip flops and slippers are not)
2. Pants- Students may choose to wear pants, shorts or skirts.
 - a. Shorts and skirts must be knee length.
 - b. Pants, shorts and skirts should be black or khaki (tan) in color.
 - c. Pants should be of “khaki” or “dress pants” material without decoration. “Cargo pants,” denim, sweatpants or pajama pants should not be worn. Leggings of a solid color may be worn beneath school appropriate skirts.
 - d. Pants should not be excessively tight or baggy without any undergarments visible.
 - i. Undergarments shall be defined as: any clothing worn under the pants, shorts, or skirts.
 - e. Students are encouraged but not required to wear belts with pants
 - i. Belts should not be of a distracting or dangerous nature
3. Shirts- Students may choose from 3 shirt styles
 - i. Oxford Style (button up w/ collar) – long or short sleeve
 - ii. Polo Style (w/ collar) – long or short sleeve
 - iii. Turtle Neck (no cowl neck designs)
 - b. Shirts must be of a solid color free of design, free of words and free of brand names and logos with the exception of students being permitted to wear a shirt or sweater with an MVHS, Yellow Jacket, or specific board of education approved club, activity, or organization.
 - c. Shirts with buttons must be worn buttoned completely with the exception of the top button or wrist buttons.
 - d. Students are encouraged but not required to tuck in their shirts.
 - e. Sweaters:
 - i. Students may wear pullover or cardigan sweaters provided they are of a solid color free of brand markings and do not contain pockets or hoods. One of the above 3 styles of shirts must be worn under the sweater.
 - f. Undergarments should not be visible through the shirts.
 - i. Undergarments shall be defined as: any clothing worn under the shirt.
 - g. Scarves and ties may be worn as long as they worn around the neck.

Administration will make the final determination of appropriateness of school attire.
